1. Part-time student PEY (Ryan)

- Part time students finishing the “second part” of their part time studies are not eligible to go on PEY (or must have their case reviewed by the career center) because to be eligible to do PEY you must leave and return as a full time student
- **Action item:** Ryan is going to speak to the director of the career center to gather more information
- **Action item:** UCC team will bring this up at the next UCC meeting
- (This may be in part because most part-time students do not get involved in EngSoc very often)

3. Mid-course Evaluations

- TMRC recommendations Update
 - Oghosa met with the TMRC
 - 4 main feedback items
 - speak with U of T Faculty Association rep (Professor Nagami)- meeting Sept 23rd, 1pm
 - meet with FIPPA about the sharing of information (registrar meeting date and time TBD)
 - meet with CUPE (unit for profs) so that they know because what we’re doing could cause conflict between students and professors (meeting date and time TBD)
 - we should promote the project as a pilot project (this may relax the profs)
- First year Class-reps assignments
 - Simo will help Oghosa with this
 - Class reps assigned to each course will talk to course coordinators
- 2nd & 3rd year Demos
 - EngSci 3rd year rep can go to classes and ask for someone to help distribute mid-course evaluations to the different options
 - **Action item:** Bernadette talk to 3rd year chem rep (and eventually 2nd year rep) to gather information about what the rep would like to do in terms of mid course evaluations
 - MSE looks good

- **Action item:** Oghosa draft a letter to give to class reps to give to course instructors, giving them the option to opt out (especially for first year)

 - Chem is good
 - **Action item:** Rossdan will talk to EngSci chair
- e. Other
 - Possibly consider holding a similar evaluation system for upper year students to evaluate, looking back, how useful first/second year courses have been during their undergraduate studies

 - PER (600 hrs of work needed to graduate) -

 - Simo made a survey (Neha reviewed) to get this sort of feedback about it from all students
 - UCC is still in process of preparing the survey
 - Survey will be distributed through EngSoc
 - There is ambiguity about what counts towards a student's PER
 - Students usually have no problem completing this requirement - is it really necessary to impose these hours as a mandatory requirement?
 - Do we keep it and make the rules more strict, or do we get rid of it all together?
 - **Action item:** bring up part time student PEY issues (see item 1 on notes)
