Approve trial status affiliation.</p> <p><u>Canadian Aeronautics and Space Institute (UofT Chapter)</u> The club’s mandate seems to overlap with the goals of the UTAT. As per Policy 2015-06-21, the applicant has three options: prove differentiation, merge with existing club or compete for affiliation. If proof of differentiation is chosen the candidate is asked to: give more specific details about the club, description, what you’d like to do, how you differ from existing clubs like UTAT.</p> <p><u>NeurotechUofT</u> Club has identified a niche, and has proven differentiation from existing clubs. Approve trial status affiliation.</p> <p><u>University of Toronto Stem Cell Club (SCC)</u> Falls out of the mandate of an EngSoc club as the application lends to the club seeming like an advocacy group.
